#### NOTICE TO STUDENT

- 1 Check with your **examination centre** about the details regarding when and where your **seating arrangements** can be seen.
- 2 You must go and check your **SSC Examination center and seat** one day prior to your paper.
- 3 You must report to the **Deputy Conductor** of your centre of examination if the furniture needs to be replaced, in case it is broken.
- 4 You must reach your centre before **10:30 am for morning session & 2:30 pm for noon session paper** on each day of examination. If you arrive in the examination hall after **half an hour of scheduled time** of the examination you will **not be allowed** to sit for the examination and will be declared **absent** for that subject examination.
- 5 You should carry **all the material required** for the examination including pencils, eraser, scale and geometrical instruments in a transparent pouch along with a transparent writing pad.
- 6 It is in your best interest to be dressed in **complete school uniform**.
- 7 You should carry your **hall ticket to the examination venue everyday**, make a copy of the same and keep it at home.
- 8 If in case you have forgotten your **hall ticket** on a particular day, ask for a temporary hall ticket.
- 9 You must write your **Seat Number** both in figures and words correctly on the answer book and supplements **only at the space provided on the cover page**. Your performance shall be **cancelled** if it is found that you have **written your seat number** ( in words or figures) **anywhere other than the space provided** for writing seat number on the cover page.
- 10 Religious symbols are not to be written at all on the answer booklet.
- 11 English should be filled as the **Language of Answer** for all subjects in the main Answer Book
- 12 You must correctly fill the **Set Code** of your **Mathematics** Question Paper in the spaces provided on the Answer Booklet.
- 13 You are not allowed to use a **stencils** except an outline map of India is allowed (without any markings) wherever applicable.
- 14 You must not become involved in any **unfair or dishonest practice before, during or after the examination**.
- 15 Possession of **unauthorised material is breaking the rules**; even if you decide, not to use it. If found in possession of unauthorised material you will be subjected to penalty and possible disqualification. You are forbidden to take any book or page, mobile phones, pager, Ipods or any kind of electronic devices in the examination hall.
- 16 You will not be allowed to borrow anything from anyone in the examination venue.
- 17 You must not talk to, attempt to communicate with or disturb other candidates once you have entered the examination venue.
- 18 You must check all the details on the **barcode sticker** as soon as you receive it and if incorrect inform the invigilator before using it.
- 19 You must follow **the instructions of the invigilator for the pasting of barcodes and holocraft** stickers, if in doubt seek the help of the invigilator.
- 20 On receiving the question paper write your **name** and **seat number**.
- 21 You must secure your paper properly in the **last 10 minutes**.
- 22 You must not staple your supplements instead use the thread provided.
