- 13 Possession of unauthorised material is breaking the rules; even if you decide, not to use it. If found in possession of unauthorised material you will be subject to penalty and possible disqualification.
- 14 You will not be allowed to borrow anything from anyone in the examination venue.
- 15 You must not:
 - have in your possession any unauthorised material, including electronic devices and mobile phones;
 - have in your possession any unauthorised equipment which might give you an unfair advantage.
- 16 You will not be given any reading time.
- 17 You must not talk to, attempt to communicate with or disturb other candidates once you have entered the examination venue.
- 18 You must follow the instructions of the invigilator.
- 19 If you are in any doubt, speak to the invigilator.
- 20 Religious symbols are not to be written on the answer booklet.
- 21 You will not be allowed to leave the block till all the papers are collected & accounted for.
