 **KEY TIME** is a part of a CIE project to increase the security of their examinations, and ensure that the validity and integrity of CIE examinations continue to be valued as a global standard. Key Time is a time identified in each morning (10:30 am) and afternoon (2:30 pm) examination session when all candidates must be under full supervision by their Centre. If the Key Time falls after the examination timing, then the candidates must be under supervision till the respective Key Time. They can have access to their books and notes, and they can talk to each other. However, they must not have any access to telephones, mobile phones, the internet, or any means of external communication; and they must not be allowed any communication with anyone not under full Centre supervision.
